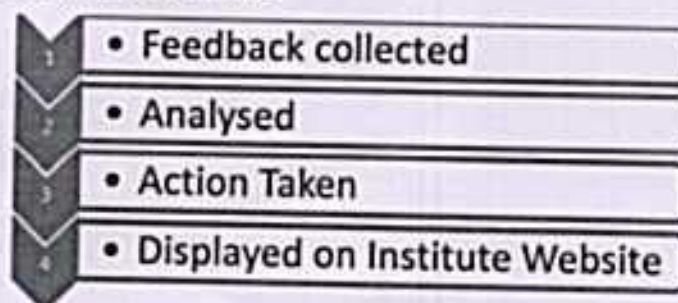
Academic Year : 2017-18 Semester- IInd

- 5. Parents:** Parent feedback collected after every parents meet about curriculum and their satisfaction.




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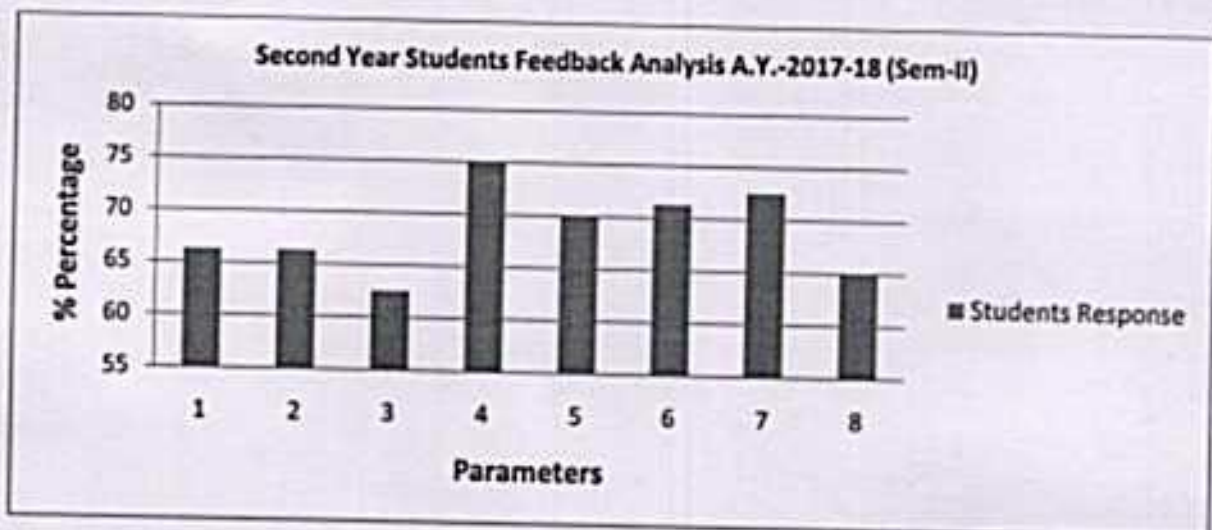
